1. **Technology Improvements at Moreland (presented by Ms. Yeager)**

Moreland has a new computer lab! With our Title I funding, we have purchased Promethean boards for most classrooms. We have also purchased teacher workstations, document cameras, digital cameras, and upgraded memory for most existing workstations. We are also doing advanced teacher training on promethean boards. Our technology goals for the future are (1) portable computer labs and classroom workstations, and (2) wireless access throughout the buildings on school campus.

Feb. 2nd PTO evening meeting will showcase the use of Promethean Boards in each grade level so that parents can become familiar with the teaching platform.
