Alex Kendrick Takes State Honors

Congratulations to junior Alex Kendrick who earned a spot on the Georgia team to compete in the National Chemistry Olympiad. Sponsored by the American Chemical Society,

the Chemistry Olympiad starts with a fierce exam at the local level and culminates in an international competition that will be held in Tokyo, Japan this year. The exam is a rigorous

five hour assessment including multiple choice, problem solving, and a laboratory practicum. Alex’s ninth highest score in the state allowed him to join a team of twelve representing Georgia to compete for a spot on the U.S. national team.

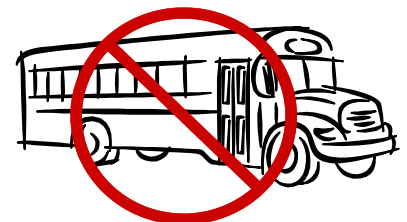
Eligible Students

Students in 10th, 11th, and 12th grades are eligible for summer school. All summer school courses—except Driver Education—are for remediation only (course previously attempted, but not passed); however, a course may be taken in a situation where a student was unable to schedule a required class for promotion or where a transfer student to our schools needs a specific course for promotion. A school counselor’s signature is required to

register for a summer school course. Students who do not attend a Coweta County public school must provide an official transcript at registration that reflects the course(s) that are to be re-taken.

Registration packets containing additional information and registration forms are available in the Guidance Office.

Transportation will NOT be provided.

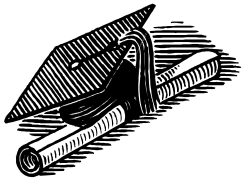

Summer GHSGT re-takes are scheduled at Newnan High as follows:

Thank you from your NHS nurse for a great first year for me! I am sad to see our seniors leave, but happy for a new class to enter in the fall!

Please remember that, by law, any medication left in the clinic after the last day of school must be destroyed. If your child will require medication for the 2010/2011 school year, please be prepared to submit a new medication consent form (provided by your school nurse) and medication in the original, labeled container.



For students who do not have a current Certificate of Immunization Form 3231 on file at Newnan High, please be prepared to submit this form prior to the first day of school. If you come during the summer, please have this form placed in my mailbox for my return in the fall. I will not be in the office during the summer. Summer office hours are posted on page one.

Speaking of summer, here are some summer safety tips while enjoying the outdoors:

- Hydrate before outdoor activities.
- Use sunscreen with an SPF of at least 15 and apply it 30 minutes before you go outside. Reapply

every 20 minutes if swimming or sweating.

- Hydrate regularly during outdoor activities.
- Plan activities for times when it is cooler outside.
- Have shade available. An umbrella can be a quick and inexpensive solution!
